

**MODIFICATION ORDER****WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981****ROYAL BOROUGH OF WINDSOR AND MAIDENHEAD  
DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT****FOOTPATH 60 COOKHAM (PART) MODIFICATION ORDER 2001**


This Order is made by the Royal Borough of Windsor and Maidenhead under Section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that Authority that the Royal Borough of Windsor and Maidenhead Definitive Map and Statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53 (3) (b) of the Act, namely, the expiration of a period such that the enjoyment by the public of the way during that period raises the presumption that the way has been dedicated as a public path.

The Royal Borough of Windsor and Maidenhead has consulted with every local authority whose area includes land to which the Order relates.

The Royal Borough of Windsor and Maidenhead hereby orders that:

1. For the purposes of this Order the relevant date is 1 October 2001.
2. The Royal Borough of Windsor and Maidenhead Definitive Map and Statement shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the Order.
3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as the Footpath 60 Cookham (Part) in the Royal Borough of Windsor and Maidenhead Modification Order 2001.

## SCHEDULE

### PART I

#### MODIFICATION OF THE DEFINITIVE MAP

(References to lettered points in the following description are references to letters on the attached map showing the path being described. All distances and directions are approximate.)

#### DESCRIPTION OF PATH TO BE ADDED

##### FOOTPATH 60 COOKHAM (PART)

The section of path bounded by Points A, B, C, D, E and F; where Point A is at the river-side edge of the concrete wharf, directly under the eastern edge of Cookham Bridge; Point B is at the north-eastern corner of the concrete wharf, distance A to B being 3.7 metres; Point C is at the close-boarded wooden fence on the eastern side of the concrete terrace, 2.0 metres south-south west of Point B; Point D is on the concrete terrace, 2.4 metres west-north-west of Point C; Point E is at the close-boarded wooden fence on the southern side of the concrete terrace, 2.0 metres south-south-west of Point D; Point F is at the fence post where the wooden fence turns through a right angle, directly under the eastern edge of Cookham Bridge, the distance between points E and F being 1.4 metres; the distance between Points F and A being 4.0 metres.

### PART II

#### MODIFICATION OF THE DEFINITIVE STATEMENT

##### FOOTPATH 60 COOKHAM

The new description of this path shall be:

“From” The NE end of Footpath 57 Cookham at Cockmarsh, E, S and SE alongside the River Thames and under Cookham Bridge

“To” Approximately 3.7 metres E of the E side of Cookham Bridge

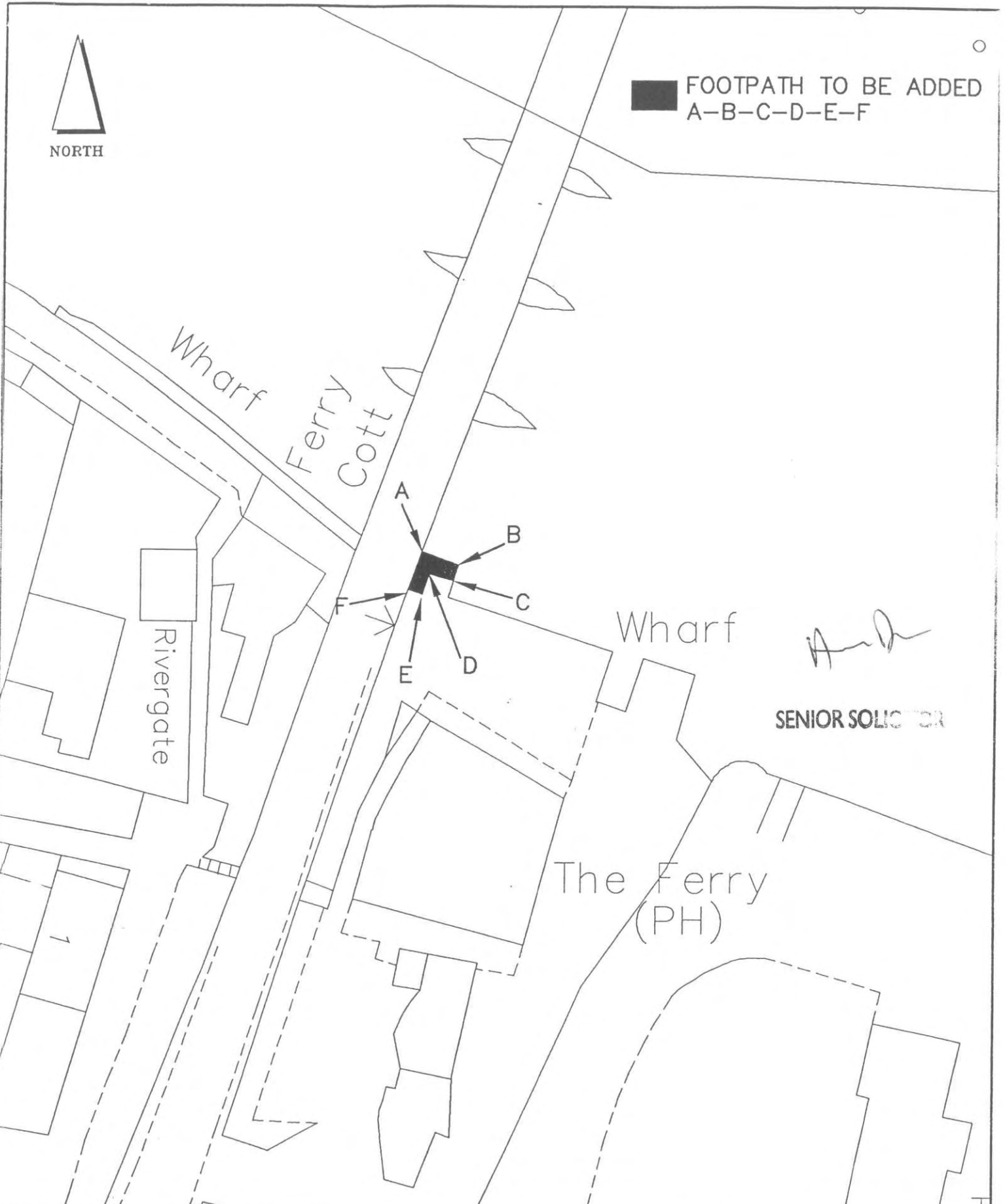

The width of the path shall be recorded as:

Between Points A and B in Modification Order 208, a minimum of 1.5 metres;  
between Points F and E in Modification Order WM10, 4.0 metres;  
between Points D and C in Modification Order WM10, 2.0 metres.
