This application for neighbourhood area designation is submitted to the Royal Borough of Windsor and Maidenhead under the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012. It is submitted on behalf of Eton Town Council.

<u>Definition of the area to which the application relates</u>

This application relates to the parished area of Eton Town Council. The proposed neighbourhood area includes the centre of Eton and the high street, the buildings of Eton College and the area of Eton Wick. The proposed neighbourhood area comprises of the ward of Eton Wick, and the section of Eton and Castle ward which is to the west of the River Thames

A map showing the boundary is provided in Appendix A to the application.

Justification for why the area is considered appropriate for designation as a neighbourhood area

The proposed neighbourhood area is the same geographical area as the parished boundary of Eton Town Council.

Eton Town Council has a strong relationship with other community groups such as Eton Traders Association, Eton Community Association, Eton College, businesses in the town, Eton Wick Village Hall, Eton Wick Sports and Social Club, the Allotments Association, Baldwins Bridge Trust, Poor Estate, and other local charities. The Town Council comprises of Members with well established links across the proposed neighbourhood area.

The network which Eton Town Council has will be used to produce a plan that meets the needs and aspirations of residents and businesses in the town. Research work on planning issues has previously been carried out by the Town Council in 2007, and this will provide an initial evidence base for the forthcoming neighbourhood plan.
